Because of you, Steven's faith in God, and himself, has been restored.

When Steven moved here with his wife a few years ago he was optimistic about the future. They had wanted a change for their children, and Oklahoma City seemed like the perfect place to raise a family.

But the health insurance Steven was using didn't transfer over, and he lost access to the pain management regimen that had kept the effects of an old leg injury at bay.

The pain became more than he could bear, and Steven turned to illicit substances to cope. Soon, Steven spiraled as a chemical

dependence took hold. He and his wife lost their home and split up. She left Oklahoma, and Steven found himself homeless and helpless, struggling to survive on the street for the next 18 months.

One day, he heard about City Rescue Mission from a friend. Steven was apprehensive at first, but as soon as he met our staff members, he knew he had come to the right place to heal.

"When I walked in, it was like a huge weight lifted off my shoulders," he recalls. "I knew I'd found a place to finally get my life together."

It is only because of the gifts of people like you that we can continue making a life-changing difference for people like Steven.

"City Rescue Mission gave me my faith, my kids and my life back," Steven says. **"From the bottom of my heart, thank you."**

At City Rescue Mission, our staff understands the importance of primary education for children. Kids experiencing homelessness are at an extreme disadvantage compared to their housed peers.

Reduced vocabularies, literacy and motor-skills combine with stress and anxiety to lower academic performance, which can lead to decreased economic opportunity.

The cycle of poverty and homelessness is brutal, but you are breaking it by supporting City Rescue Mission.

Your gifts are helping children like Scarlett, who recently started attending school after coming to the Mission with her mom. After dropping out of school to help support her family, Scarlett's mom knows the importance of a good education.
